

The Small Business of the Year Awards recognize and honor four Fort Worth small businesses demonstrating best practices in business. These awards are presented annually at FWC's State of the City.

SUSAN HALSEY EXECUTIVE LEADERSHIP AWARD

The Susan Halsey Executive Leadership Award recognizes and honors presidents, principals or chief executive officers, demonstrating leadership excellence in business in the Fort Worth area. This award is presented annually at FWC's Annual Meeting.

VANDERGRIFF AWARD

The Vandergriff Award recognizes a legacy individual/organization whose contributions have and will continue to positively impact Tarrant County on a national scale. This award is presented annually at FWC's State of the County.

YOUNG PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Young Professional of the Year (YP) Award recognizes a YP who is trailblazing a path forward in Fort Worth. The recipient of this award exemplifies leadership in their industry, organization and/or community. This award is presented annually at FWC's YP Summit.
